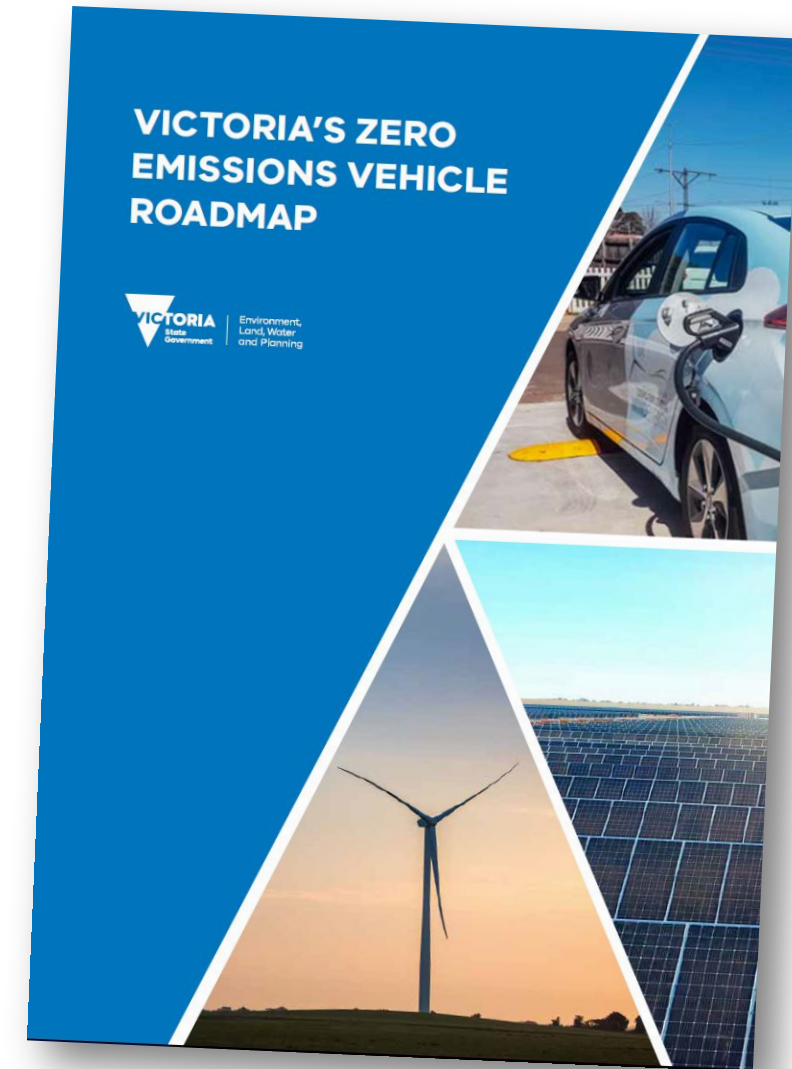

May 2021 announcements included:

- \$100 million ZEV support package:
 - \$46 million for Australia's first public ZEV Subsidy, \$3,000 per vehicle
 - \$19 million for charging infrastructure across regional Victoria and fleets
 - 100 per cent new ZEV buses from 2025, \$20 million ZEV bus trial
 - \$10 million for greener government fleet, \$5 million for ZEV innovation fund
- 2030 target for 50% of all new light vehicle sales to be ZEV
- Expert Advisory Panel on 2030 sales target

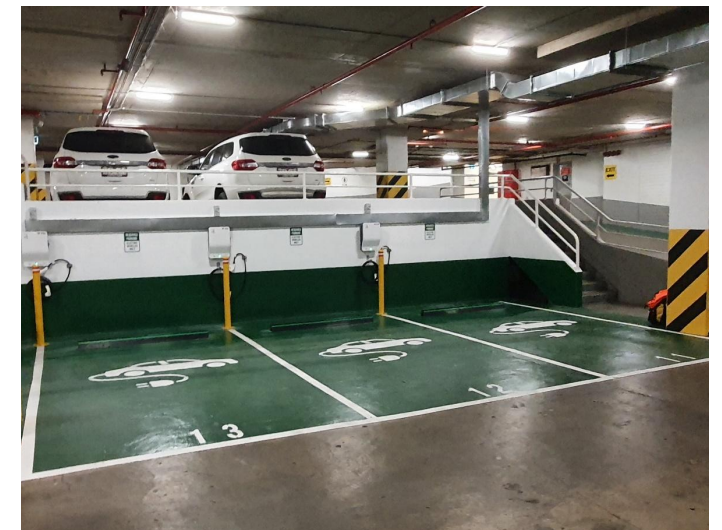
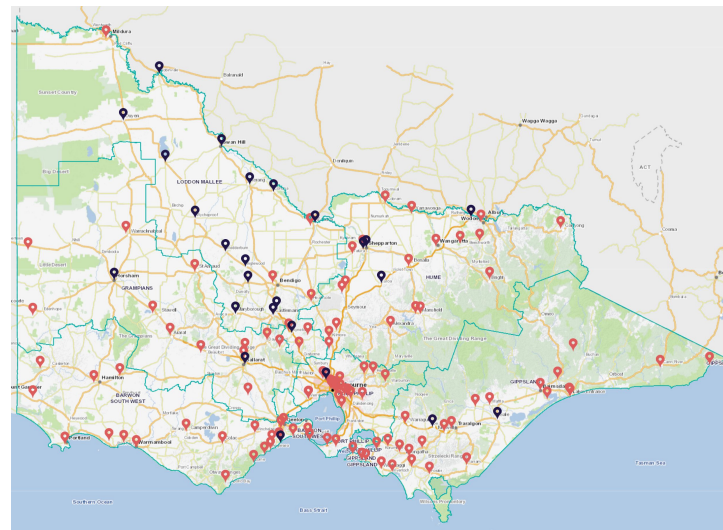
